



2022 Primary Election Absentee Voting



Absentee voting for the August 9, 2022 Primary Election begins June 24, 2022 and runs through August 8, 2022.

Chisago County residents can absentee vote in-person at the Chisago County Government Center, 313 North Main Street, Center City, MN 55012 during regular business hours Monday through Friday. The Government Center will be open for absentee voting Saturday, August 6, 2022 from 10 a.m.-3 p.m.

You can also absentee vote by mail. To request a ballot be mailed to you an application is required. You can apply for your ballot:

- By completing an online Absentee Ballot Application at www.mnvotes.org and clicking “Other Ways to Vote”
- By printing a paper application from the County website and returning it to the Auditor-Treasurer’s Office <https://www.chisagocountymn.gov/140/Absentee-Voting>
- By contacting the Auditor-Treasurer’s Office and requesting an application be mailed to you.
