

MINUTES ON INFORMATIONAL MEETING TO DISCUSS ROAD  
IMPROVEMENTS ON 245<sup>TH</sup> STREET  
CHISAGO LAKE TOWNSHIP BOARD  
TUESDAY June 19, 2018

Sheriff Brandon Thyen introduced himself and gave a presentation previous to calling the meeting to order.

The informational meeting was then called to order by Chair Stirling at 6:40 pm. All Board members were present, Engineer Dan Boyum, and several property owners. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was said by the assembled group. After calling the meeting to order Chair Stirling introduced the Board members and the Township Engineer Dan Boyum. Chair Stirling explained to the constituents that were present that this is a dead end road so the Township covers 25% of the cost and the residents are responsible for the other 75% of the cost. Chair Stirling also let them know that we have petitions available for them to sign depending on which option they choose once Engineer Dan Boyum has explained the options and we will need the petitions returned as soon as possible, to know if we need to adjust our 2019 tax levy. Chair Stirling then turned the meeting over to Engineer Dan Boyum. Dan explained the two options, summarizing the costs per parcel. Dan Boyum then opened the meeting for comments and questions. Several constituents were concerned with all the people that fish in the culvert along 245<sup>th</sup> Street. Sheriff Thyen informed them that the Sheriff's department cannot prevent people from fishing on the road-right-of-way, however they can address the people that are parking in the No Parking zones. After discussion the Board agreed to look at the culvert fishing issue.

There being no further discussion a motion was made by Stirling, seconded by Houle to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 p.m. Motion carried.
