

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED ASSESSMENT FOR THE  
2019 STREET IMPROVEMENTS  
CHISAGO LAKE TOWNSHIP BOARD  
TUESDAY October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The HEARING was called to order at 6:35 pm by Chair Stirling. All Board members were present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was said by the assembled group. Chair Stirling then turned the hearing over to the Township Engineer, Dan Boyum. Dan gave an overview of the project and final costs. Engineer Boyum pointed out that there are two final assessment rolls, one is the original listing a total of 38 parcels, the second alternative is to keep all the assessments the same and eliminate one parcel, #02.00302.00 due to a wetland related issue. Dan then opened the hearing up for discussion. Chair Stirling informed everyone present that we did receive a written Objection Form from Mark and Diane Hanson, parcel #02.01790.85, requesting a revision of assessment on their parcel. The Board decided to take no action.

A motion was made by Houle, seconded by Reed, to close the meeting. Chair Stirling then closed the meeting at 6:58 pm.
