Resolution for Hearing on Proposed Assessment

WHEREAS, by a resolution passed by the Town Board on March 19, 2019, the township the township entered into a contract with North Valley, Inc. for blacktopping the existing gravel roads of 245th Street between Lofton Avenue and Miller Avenue and 245th Street between Miller Avenue to approximately 1,440 feet North and reclamation of Miller Avenue from 245th Street to the South End, 244th Street from Miller Avenue to Moody Lane, and Moody Lane from 244th Street to Miller Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF CHISAGO LAKE TOWNSHIP, MINNESOTA:

- 1. The township clerk is directed to prepare a proposed assessment of the cost of blacktopping the existing gravel roads of 245th Street between Lofton Avenue and Miller Avenue and 245th Street between Miller Avenue to approximately 1,440 feet North.
- 2. A hearing shall be held at 6:30 p.m. on October 15, 2019 in the Chisago Lake Township Hall Building located at 12400 316th Street, Lindstrom to pass upon such proposed assessment. All persons owning property affected by such improvement will be given an opportunity to be heard with reference to such assessment.
- 3. The town clerk is hereby directed to cause a notice of the hearing on the proposed assessment to be published once in the official newspaper at least two weeks prior to the hearing, and she shall state in the notice the total cost of the improvement. She shall also cause mailed notice to be given to the owner of each parcel described in the assessment roll not less than two weeks prior to the hearing.
- 4. The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the county auditor, pay the whole of the assessment on such property, with interest accrued to the date of payment, to Chisago Lake Township, except that no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid within 30 days from the adoption of the assessment. An owner may at any time thereafter, pay to Chisago Lake Township, the entire amount of the assessment remaining unpaid, with interest accrued to December 31 of the year in which such payment is made. Such payment must be made before November 15 or interest will be charged through December 31 of the succeeding year.
